Addressing Issues Impacting Advanced Nursing Practice ...
Advanced practice is a level of practice, rather than a type or specialty of practice. Advanced practitioners are educated at masters level in advanced practice and are assessed as competent in practice, using expert knowledge and skills.

The Advanced Practice Registered Nurse designation is not used for the Integrative Health and Healing DNP graduate. This designation is reserved for advanced practice nurses prepared as certified nurse specialists, nurse midwives, nurse practitioners and nurse anesthetists, recognizing their ability to prescribe pharmaceuticals.

A systematic review of experiences of advanced practice ...
The significance of this integrative review is noted in the presentation of the ongoing process of SDM. Box (1 1) below provides a case study that exemplifies this ongoing process.
