CDL Restrictions. A restriction placed on your commercial driver's license may keep you from operating certain types of vehicles. Common federal CDL restriction codes are listed below: E Restriction: Prohibits you from operating vehicles with a manual transmission. Occurs when you take your skills test in a CMV with automatic transmission.

Class A CDL—Needed for driving a combination of vehicles, such as a truck with a trailer attached, that are over a certain weight. Class B CDL—Used for driving single vehicles that are over a certain weight. Class C CDL—Needed for driving vehicles over a certain weight not covered by Class A or Class B commercial driver's licenses.
