The initial step is a baseline patient assessment, including an assessment of the patient's risk of readmission. Risk factors for readmission include clinical issues, such as advanced chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), heart failure, stroke, diabetes, significant unintended weight loss, depression, cancer, and palliative care.

The Joint Commission (TJC) notes that the “most common root causes of sentinel events are human factors, leadership, and communication” and has identified ineffective communication as the cause of 80% of medical errors. 5,6.
