The aforementioned case report from Hong Kong shows that re-infection is possible. The main questions is, how common is re-infection? Studies of people who have recovered from SARS-CoV-2 suggest that, while many individuals have some neutralizing antibodies present in their blood, the levels are very low for ~ 1/3 of samples. If the presence of neutralizing antibodies protect against infection (as suggested above), this suggests that potentially 1/3 of infected individuals could be ...
