Basic book citation format. The APA in-text citation for a book includes the author's last name, the year, and (if relevant) a page number. In the reference list, start with the author's last name and initials, followed by the year. The book title is written in sentence case (only capitalize the first word and any proper nouns).

To cite a book in MLA, start by listing the author's last name followed by their first name, separated by a comma. Then, add a period at the end of their first name, and provide the title of the book in italics with a period at the end.

If you have to cite a specific edition of a book later than the first, you should indicate the new edition in your citation. If the book is a revised edition or an edition that includes substantial new content, include the number, name, or year of the edition and the abbreviation "ed." in parentheses between the book title and the period that follows it.

To cite a chapter in a book in a reference entry in APA style 6th edition include the following elements: Author(s) of the chapter: Give the last name and initials (e. g. Watson, J. D.) of up to seven authors with the last name preceded by an ampersand (&). For eight or more authors include the first six names followed by an ellipsis (...) and add the last author's name.

The basic structure of a book reference should list the author's last name, first initials, publication year, book title, and publisher. For example: Rogers, C. R. (1961).

The Right Way to List Book References in APA Format

Your citation of a book in your reference list typically begins with the last name of the author of the book. After the last name, place a comma, and then type the first and middle initials of the author. Example: "Doe, J. H." If there are 2 authors, separate their names with an ampersand ("Doe, J. H. & Rowell, L. C."). For 3 or more authors, use commas between the names and an ampersand before the final name ("Doe, J. H., Rowell, L. C. & Hoffman, M. A.").
