### Sexual Dysfunction & Disorders: Treatment, Symptoms ...

Mechanical aids: Aids such as vacuum devices and penile implants may help men with erectile dysfunction (the inability to achieve or maintain an erection). A vacuum device (EROS-CTD™) is also approved for use in women, but can be expensive. Dilators may help women who experience narrowing of the vagina.

Possible treatments for female sexual dysfunction might include: Estrogen therapy. Localized estrogen therapy comes in the form of a vaginal ring, cream or tablet. This therapy benefits sexual function by improving vaginal tone and elasticity, increasing vaginal blood flow and enhancing lubrication.

When antidepressant-induced sexual dysfunction has developed, try to persuade the patient to wait in case tolerance develops. Then consider changing to a lower risk or use of high/low risk antidepressant combinations but pharmacological expertise is required.
