An electronystagmography test evaluates balance by detecting abnormal, involuntary eye movements, a condition known as nystagmus. Nystagmus may occur as a result of inner ear complications such as an acoustic neuroma. A BAER exam checks hearing and neurological function and interaction by recording the brain's response to certain sounds.

Vestibular testing: This includes a series of examinations to test how well your vestibular system is working, including electronystagmography or videonystagmography. Both of these tests record eye movements in different situations, and these movements can provide clues to the function of the inner ear.
