(And the White House Council of Economic Advisors cited our work on this in their War on Poverty 50 Years Later Report, released today.)

Inequality Is the Main Cause of Persistent Poverty ...

The poverty thresholds are adjusted each year to reflect changes in the consumer price index. The poverty rate is the percentage of people living in poverty. The official poverty statistics show a sharp decline in the poverty rate between 1959 and 1969 but little real change since then, apart from fluctuations due to the business cycle.

The poverty rate is the ratio of the number of people (in a given age group) whose income falls below the poverty line; taken as half the median household income of the total population. It is also available by broad age group: child poverty (0-17 years old), working-age poverty and elderly poverty (66 year-olds or more).

The number of children in families with below-poverty earnings rose by 4.9 million (34 percent), from 14.4 million to 19.4 million. Between June 2019 and June 2020, the number of non-elderly individuals with below-poverty family earnings rose by nearly 10 million.

The poverty rate amongst the 'White - Other' group was 25% (80,000 people) and that of the 'White - British' group was 18% (860,000 people). 39% of single women with children are living in poverty. 29% of those who live with a disabled household member live in poverty.
