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In a non-reversible reaction this would be about the long and short of it, but when a reaction is reversible the products can also react to produce the reactants again. After a time, a reversible reaction in a closed system can reach what we call a 'dynamic equilibrium'.

Reversible Reactions. In reversible reactions, the reactants and products are never fully consumed; they are each constantly reacting and being produced. A reversible reaction can take the following summarized form:
$$[A + B \underset{\{k_{-1}\}}{\{\overset{\{k_1\}}{\rightleftharpoons\}} C + D]$$
 This reversible reaction can be broken into two reactions.

Reversible vs. Irreversible Reactions - Chemistry LibreTexts

At equilibrium, the rate of the forward reaction (CH₄ decomposing into C₂H₂ and H₂) is equal to the rate of the reverse reaction (C₂H₂ and H₂ reacting to form CH₄). At equilibrium, the concentrations of all substances are not changing. At equilibrium, both the forward and reverse reactions are still occurring.
