First, some syntactic analysis (e.g., building a parse tree) is performed on the source text. Second, the syntactic structure is converted (aka transferred) into a corresponding structure in the target language. Finally, output is generated from the syntactic structure of the target language.

Syntactic Analysis : Syntactic Analysis of a sentence is the task of recognising a sentence and assigning a syntactic structure to it. These syntactic structures are assigned by the Context Free Grammar (mostly PCFG) using parsing algorithms like Cocke-Kasami-Younger (CKY), Earley algorithm, Chart Parser. They are represented in a tree structure.
