In 2018 the Louisiana Legislature changed many of the Louisiana Civil Code Articles. The changes have already gone into effect. In total, twenty one (21) articles were amended, three (3) were enacted, and one (1) was repealed. The new text of the Civil Code articles is copied below.

In 1825, Haiti promulgated a Code Civil, that was simply a copy of the Napoleonic one; while Louisiana abolished its Digeste, replacing it with the Code Civil de l'État de la Louisiane the same year.

In Louisiana, the laws regarding the valid execution and witnessing of a Will are set forth in the Louisiana Civil Code, Articles 1577 through 1582.1. In Louisiana there is not a required statutory age or mental capacity to execute a Will. A Will must be in writing, signed at the end by the testator, by two witnesses and a notary. (See: Art. 1577)
