DIFFERENT WAYS OF KNOWING AND DEVELOPMENT. There are different types of knowledge and different ways of knowing. Schumacher 7 and then Wilber 8 articulated a systematic way to bring together different perspectives that collectively reveal a rounded view. As shown in Figure 1 ↓, these ways of knowing have 2 dimensions: inner/outer and individual/collective.
