Push apart the baby's buttocks with your thumb and forefinger. Using your other hand, gently insert the lubricated bulb end of the thermometer 1/2 to 1 inch, or just past the anal muscle. Point thermometer towards the child's belly button. Hold the thermometer with 1 hand on the baby's buttocks so the thermometer will move with the baby.
